No	Question	Answer
1	When playing boccia each individual or team has a set of coloured balls. What are the colours?	Red and blue.
2	What is the colour and name of the other ball used in boccia?	White, jack ball.
3	What is the aim of the game?	To propel red and blue balls as near as possible to the white, jack ball.
4	How can boccia balls be propelled?	Rolled, thrown, kicked or released down a ramp.
5	How does the game commence?	The red team throws the jack and then their first red ball.
6	How is a point scored?	When all the balls have been thrown, the side whose ball is closest to the jack scores a point.
7	How are additional points scored?	The side whose ball is closest to the jack is given an additional point for each ball that is closer to the jack than an opponent's ball.
8	Name a type of assistive device that a player can use to propel a ball when playing boccia?	Ramp, chute, head pointer.
